

2.2.1. Technical Director

ABOUT THE ROLE

The club will appoint a suitably qualified Technical Director (TD) to oversee all the club's coach education and player development programs. The TD is also responsible for the appointment criteria for coaches and managers, establishment of playing/coaching standards and expectations. The TD is responsible for establishing the club playing and coaching 'culture' and philosophies and will have club administrative management responsibilities for the every-day operations of the club.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- The minimum coaching qualification for the Senior Coach position is an AFC 'A" License, presently enrolled on and in the process of completing an "A" License course or recognised equivalent.
- The minimum coaching qualification for the TD position is an AFC 'A" Licence or recognised equivalent.
- The Technical Director must have a working with children check.
- The TD must demonstrate exceptional organisational and management capabilities, extensive football coach educational qualifications and experience and proven experience in strategic planning and program development.
- Candidates for this role may be asked to demonstrate their practical coaching abilities in an accessible training session.
- The TD will be responsible for developing a club coaching and playing strategy and programming for delivery to all user groups within the club. All programs will meet with the FFA national curriculum and Holland Park Hawks FC overall playing philosophies which integrate MiniRoos, FQ Academy, FQ Metro, and Senior football.
- The TD will be appointed for a term negotiated by the club.
