ABOUT THE ROLE

To support Junior Development Officer in ensuring the entirety of the community space is adequately serviced and supported.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Working towards 'AFC' C License.
- Working with children check.
- First Aid and CPR Certificate.
- Work closely with the Junior Development Officer, to ensure that the community teams are working in line with the Holland Park Hawks values, mission, and vision.
- Ensure that community teams are working in line with the Holland Park Hawks team model.
- Communicate and liaise with community coaches and feedback these communications to the Junior Development Officer.
- Work on a roster to ensure that you can attend each divisional teams training once a month minimum to work with the coaches and players.
- Be present on Saturday mornings to coordinate and oversee Miniroos and Small Sided Football.
 - Ensure that the coaches of the mini-hawks program are working within what is expected of them and help them in actively engaging with the participants.
 - Ensure that small-sided football fields are set up and all games are running to schedule.
 - Provide first aid to any players which sustain injury.
 - Provide support to coaches on match days and liaise with them on any challenges they are having.
 - Be a point of contact for parents and players who need assistance at the grounds.
