

## 2.2.2. FQPL Men's Head Coach

## **ABOUT THE ROLE**

The club will appoint a suitably qualified Senior Coach to manage the performance phase of the club's senior men's FQPL program. This person must meet with the club's core values and culture, be organised and able to manage the FQPL senior program (U23 and First Team).

## APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- The minimum coaching qualification for the Senior Coach position is an AFC 'A" License, presently enrolled on and in the process of completing an "A" License course or recognised equivalent.
- The Head Coach must have a working with children check.
- The Senior Coach must demonstrate exceptional organisational and management capabilities and extensive football coach educational qualifications.
- The Senior Coach is responsible for the development of an annual training plan.
- Team periodisation which must include:
  - Football specific conditioning.
  - o Tactical outcomes relevant to the teams anticipated performance.
  - Be reflected in the planning for the U23 team.
- Candidates for this role may be asked to demonstrate their practical coaching abilities in an accessible training session.
- The selection panel will consist of an independent panel with suitable expertise convened by the Executive Committee and chaired by the Technical Director.
- An additional compliance requirement is maintaining records of each training session. These will be stored by the TD electronically
- The Senior Coach will be appointed for a term negotiated by the club.
