



2.2.3. FQ Academy Head Coach

ABOUT THE ROLE

The club will appoint a suitably qualified FQ Academy junior coaches to manage the skill acquisition, and game training phases of the clubs FQ Academy program to comply with the FQ Academy program requirements.

APPLICANT REQUIREMENTS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- The minimum coaching qualification for the FQ Academy Coach position is an AFC ‘C’ License.
- All FQ Academy coaches must have a working with children check.
- The FQ Academy Coach must follow an annual training plan which is set and managed by the Club’s Technical Director.
- A pre-season training framework will be provided for the coaches to deliver to their teams. Ongoing competition programming will run in consultation with the Technical Director. All programs will align with the Holland Park Hawks FC Team Model.
- Candidates for this role may be asked to demonstrate their practical coaching abilities in an accessible training session
- The selection process and criteria will involve an interview and consultation process with the Technical Director.
- FQ Academy coaches must write and format session plans in line with the club’s session planning procedures.
- FQ Academy coaches must attend all training sessions, games, and coach meetings.
- All coaches will be appointed for a one-year term after which the after which the position will be reviewed.
